

PHLOX is suited to shady woodlands as well as sunny garden borders. Phlox divaricata and stolonifera spread through the shade garden with pastel springtime flowers. The bright spring blooms of Phlox subulata are a familiar sight, spreading in gardens or lawns in full sun. Phlox paniculata (Tall Summer Phlox) are old-fashioned favorites in a range of bright colors, great for cutting, attractive to butterflies, and often fragrant.
