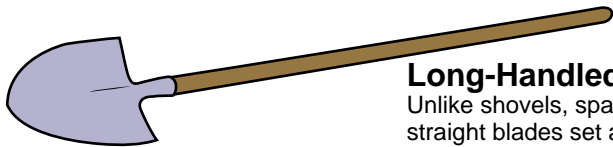
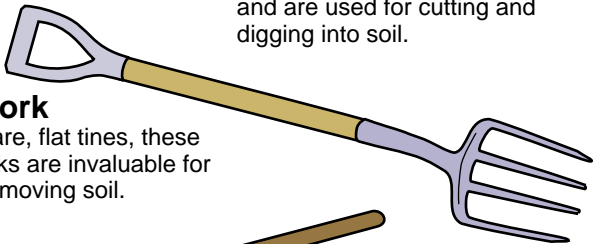


These five tools are essential for real gardening...



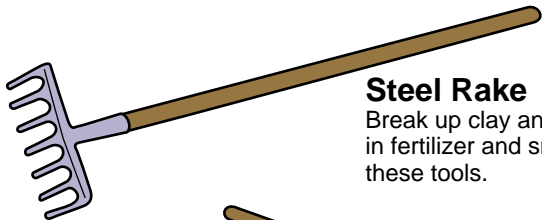
Long-Handled Spade

Unlike shovels, spades have straight blades set at an angle and are used for cutting and digging into soil.



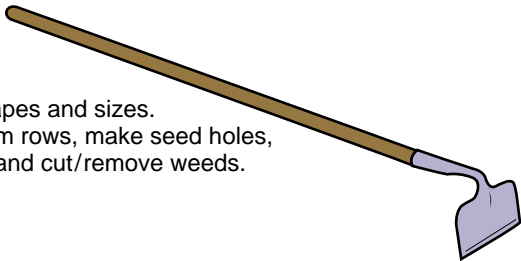
Spading Fork

With their square, flat tines, these heavy-duty forks are invaluable for preparing and moving soil.



Steel Rake

Break up clay and soil clods, rake in fertilizer and smooth out soil with these tools.



Hoe

Hoes come in all shapes and sizes. They are used to form rows, make seed holes, cover seeds, till soil and cut/remove weeds.



Hand Trowel

Trowels are efficient for marking rows, weeding, making furrows, potting and moving smaller plants.
